It is a great time of the year with summer in sight and the longer and warmer days being welcome, hopefully a good fall of rain will soon follow and a productive season for all.

Council has been very active in the Eaglehawk area with several projects underway.

The town hall has had the new air conditioning fitted and with summer not far away this is most welcome.

Canterbury park has seen the commencement of the new electronic scoreboard and this will be a great asset for the community.

The new spectator shelter design has been done and will be going out to tender in the next few weeks.

The Peter Krenz Leisure Centre has had a spring clean and new windows and resurfacing of the toddlers pool surrounds should maintain it as a great place to visit and use.

The Albert Roy changerooms and pavilion are completed and build on the renewal of the sporting precinct in Eaglehawk.

The BMX track, toilets and kiosk are now complete and track resurfacing has taken place, landscaping works will be undertaken in the near future.

Victoria and Paton street, intersection has received blackspot funding to install a splitter island and channelization.

Glenfell Avenue has received some upgrades to drainage.

Whipstick ward councillors will be conducting a tour of some of the facilities in Eaglehawk as we move into 2020.

Do you know how your Eaglehawk Community House supports our local people?

We are a low cost, or no cost if possible, service to EVERYONE in the Community and open Monday to Friday from 9am until 3pm.

EVERYONE IS WELCOME.

We provide a range of low cost activities for ANYONE to participate including basic computer classes, art, craft and sewing classes, kids playgroups, men's and ladies groups, meditation and tai chi, gardening, pantry bingo or just buzz in for a cup of tea and a chat with our friendly volunteers. We are here to assist however



we can. We regularly have special personal growth courses like 'Take Charge Of Your Life' and in February 2020 we will also begin our 'Learn to Cook' classes in partnership with the Grow Cook Share program. So register your interest with the ECH as there are limited places.

Community lunch is every Tuesday at noon and Community dinner every Tuesday at 6.00pm. EVERYONE IS WELCOME..!!

And Egg + Bacon brekkie is every Thursday from 8:00am with each sandwich costing only \$1.00 so come in and enjoy brekkie with us.

We also provide assistance with food, personal products and cat & dog food for those that may need a bit of a helping hand Monday to Friday 9am until 2.30pm.

Anyone that knows anything about the Eaglehawk Community House, knows that we just like to have fun.....and food..... and lots of it.....!!

And our amazing Team members make sure that no one leaves empty handed.

In 2019, over \$60,000 was raised for the Eaglehawk Community House to undergo much needed upgrades and improvements including a brand new kitchen with shiny modern appliances which can be hired to prepare for your function or special event.

We have an additional bathroom for visitor comfort and over the Christmas period are creating larger spaces inside to cater for our growing number of visitors. Our gardens and grounds are looking lovely with the inclusion of a new shade sail at the front of our House. Several areas are still to be completed in 2020 including our tranquillity space under the outdoor veranda and our front of house area where visitors will be able to relax. unwind and enjoy.

Chicken Drumsticks
Tin Apricot Nectar
1 packet French Onion Soup

Brown chicken drumsticks in frying pan. Turn regularly to ensure even cooking.

In a saucepan place apricot nectar and French onion soup. Heat and stir until slightly thickened.

Place browned chicken drumsticks into baking dish and pour over apricot sauce..

Bake for 30 mins or until chicken is cooked right through.

Serve on a bed of rice or with mashed potato and steamed/boiled vegetables of your choice.
